

Who votes

Group Committees

Consists of Group Committee Members,
Group Commissioner, Section Scouters
Sponsor / partners, youth members 16 older

Selects 3 Council Voting Reps from each group; ie. If your council has 100 Groups, there would be 300 people.

Area Service Teams

Made up from Area Commissioner,
Area Service team volunteers, Youth Commissioners

Selects 4 Council Voting Reps from each area in the council, one must be a Youth Member, 16 or older; ie. If your council has 10 areas, there would be 40 people.

Council Service Team

Made up from Council Commissioner
Council Service team volunteers, Youth Commissioners

Selects 4 Council Voting Reps from Council Service Team;
One of which must be a Youth Member, 16 or older.

Council Voting Reps elect Voting Members

3 Voting Members per council elected.
(One must be a Youth Member, 16 or older) Attend AGM

Annual General Meeting

Decisions/elections made by all Voting Members which include;
3 Voting Members elected by each Council
Incumbent BOG members, Honorary Officers
and others as per the By-Law

Nominations for Voting Members from each council

Any 5 Ordinary Members within a given council may nominate a member in good standing to serve as a Voting Member for their council.
Youth Nominees are required.

Voting Member Nominees

One of which must be a Youth Member 16 or older

Nominations for Board of Governors

Any Ordinary Member may submit names to the National Nominating Committee for consideration to the slate. Any 5 Voting Members may directly nominate a person to the slate to stand for election.
Eligibility, includes mandatory Youth aged 18 or older, according to the By-Law
